

Chile, winner of Alacero 2018 Contest

Alacero - Cartagena de Indias, November 6th, 2018.

Yesterday, November 5th, was developed the finals of 11th Alacero Design in Steel Competition for Students of Architecture 2018, whose theme was a Greenhouse Pavilion for a Botanical Park.

The First Place went to the team from Chile composed by Trinidad Hermosilla, Diego Concha and Tomás Aguirre of the Finis Terrae University, who were led by the teachers Andrés Echeverría and Cristián Lecaros. The team of students received a certificate and US\$ 6,000. Also, the University received US\$ 4,000.

The Second Place went to the students from Brasil, João Pedro Sommacal de Mello, Felipe Fachini Maia, Camilla Duarte Gubeissi and Kelly da Rocha Comparsi from Presbiteriana Mackenzie University, which tutor is Renato Carrieri. The team received a diploma and the sum of US2,000 and the University US\$ 1,000.

Also, Colombia received a Mention of Honor. Integrated by Salomón Puentes Hernández, Juan Camilo Vásquez Cardona, Oscar Javier Gutiérrez Peña and Andrés Felipe Morales Gómez from the University de las Salle. The tutor is Helmuth Ramos Calonge and Carlos Manrique.

In this occasion, the jury was composed by the architects Sebastián Colle (Argentina), Carolina Fonseca (Brazil), Alvaro Donoso (Chile), Juan Mubarak (Dominican Republic), Felipe Vejarano (Colombia) and Luis Enrique López Cardiel (Mexico).

The competition took place during the Latin American Steel Conference (Alacero-59) that is being held until November 07 in Cartagena de Indias, Colombia. The contest is an initiative of the Latin American Steel Association (Alacero) to encourage a relationship of professionals with steel as a construction material, leveraging all its features, among future architecture professionals.
